Funding for The Fair's Scholarship Program and other community outreach initiatives are made possible through the proceeds earned by The Miami-Dade County Fair during the 18 days of The Fair as well as off-season rentals of the fairgrounds and its facilities.

Presented by Pepsi, Kia Motors America and Sedano's Supermarkets, the Miami-Dade County Fair & Exposition recently celebrated its 61st year and is ranked as the largest fair in Florida, hosting well over a half a million guests annually. In cooperation with the Miami-Dade County Public Schools, The Fair annually showcases the artistic and academic talents of more than 45,000 students through competition and exhibitions.
