It's a 'Superstars of Wrestling Live' Showdown at The Youth Fair on Friday, March 14th

For one night, on Friday, March 14, 2014, the *Superstars of Wrestling Live Presented by XSE Live* will thrill audiences with their eye squinting and jaw dropping body slams and tangles.

"Superstars of Wrestling Live" Presented by XSE Live begins at 8 p.m. The lineup includes:

- Dusty Rhodes- Best known by his fans as "The American Dream," Rhodes has a magnetism that simply draws audiences to him. From Florida to New York City, crowds line up to see Rhodes deliver his Bionic Elbow to rivals.
- Carlos Colon Jr.- A Puerto Rican professional wrestler better known internationally by his ring name "Carlito." He made his debut performing on the main event of SmackDown! as Carlito Caribbean Cool. He is a former United States Champion and Intercontinental Champion and has been part of both the Raw and SmackDown brands. He is the only wrestler to win a championship on two separate debuts in WWE and the second Puerto Rican to become Intercontinental Champion after Pedro Morales.
- Wes Brisco- An American professional wrestler known for his time in Total Nonstop Action Wrestling (TNA), where he is a former member of Aces & Eights. He is a member of the Brisco wrestling family; the son of former Championship Wrestling from Florida mainstay Gerald Brisco, and the nephew of former NWA World Heavyweight Champion, Jack Brisco.

- Jesse Serensen An American professional wrestler heartthrob, who is best known for his time in Total Nonstop Action Wrestling (TNA), where he suffered a severe neck injury. Sorensen's doctors estimated that he could need up to one year to fully recover from his injury. In 2013, a fan asked him when he'll come back. Sorensen said there will not be a come back, but there will be a new beginning.
- *Kenneth Cameron* An English professional wrestler and actor. He is best known for his work as a wrestler on WWE programming.

Also part of the *Superstars of Wrestling Live* lineup are: Arthur Haug, JD Michaels, Lince Dorado, Tom Lamiter, Johnny Armani, Eli Vega, T Bone Funk, Michael Laccharin, Mark Silva, Andrew Levine and Steve Madison.
