Registration Deadline: January 14, 2020 Release Date: April 6, 2020, 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM at The Garden

Each school is limited to 15 of their best landscape designs which will be judged and possibly selected for landscape construction.

Landscape Beginning Installation:

March 7, 2020, from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM in The Garden. Construction MUST be started by March 8, 2020. Students may begin installation March 7, from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM, March 8, from 10:00 AM to 9:00 PM, March 9 and March 10 from 4:00 PM to 9:00 PM. All installations must be completed by 9:00 PM March 10. Decorative items may be added and touch-up completed on March 12, 2020 between 1:00 PM and 6:00 PM ONLY.

NOTE: Decorative items include non-plant elements such as tables, chairs, benches, statuary, artwork and potted plants. This is not to include items such as gazebos, fences, trellis or other items which are normally a permanent fixture in a landscape. Touch-up includes cleaning, addition of a small amount of mulch, and limited replacement/addition of plants.

Landscape Completion Date: March 10, 2020, to be completed by 9:00 PM

Rules:

- 1. An original landscape scaled drawing must be attached to your entry form. Any scaled drawing that does not have an entry form will be returned and/or disqualified.
- 2. ON THE BACK OF YOUR SCALED DRAWING, list names of all team members (alternates will NOT be allowed), names of plants, <u>quantity</u> <u>needed</u>, and explanation of any special design feature. Students may only select plants for their design from the approved plant list. Look online for plant images.
- 3. Give the judges as much information as you think would be helpful to them, and remember to be neat.
- 4. This scaled drawing will be the deciding factor as to who may enter the Landscape Construction Competition.
- 5. Entries must be submitted by an Agricultural Education teacher or 4-H leader.
- 6. Landscape location will be assigned by a lottery drawing.
- Landscape drawing MUST be equivalent to original scaled drawing and may be hand-drawn or a computer assisted drawing (CAD). Visit, https://www. youtube.com/watch?v=PgsSvBYAMJA for more information.
- 8. Size of all landscapes will be 15 feet x 8 feet.

- 9. All physical installation of plant material and decoration must be done by students.
- 10. Students are required to provide all equipment necessary to construct their landscape. (i.e., Shovels, Wheelbarrows, etc.)
- 11. Landscape teams will consist of no more than 4 students.
- 12. Sand and mulch ties will be provided by The Fair.
- 13. Completed landscape will be judged on March 12, 2020, at 7:00 PM in The Garden. One representative from each exhibit must be present. (Please follow exhibitors attire)
- 14. The above guidelines will be strictly enforced.
- 15. Any student currently graduated from, or dropped out of high school, shall be ineligible to show.
- 16. All specimens including non plant elements are entered at the sole risk of the exhibitor.
- 17. No styrofoam allowed.
