THE YOUTH FAIR AND UNITEDHEALTHCARE SOUTH FLORIDA PARTNER WITH MIAMI RESCUE MISSION TO FIGHT HUNGER IN SOUTH FLORIDA

Together They Collected More Than 10,000 Donations and 10,000 lbs Worth of Canned Foods

MIAMI, FL – April 13, 2015 - The Miami-Dade County Youth Fair & Exposition, together with Miami Rescue Mission | Broward Outreach Centers and United Healthcare joined forces to help feed the hungry of South Florida, while offering Youth Fair guests an opportunity to support the cause and earn a special discount.

The Give a Meal, Get a Deal offer began on Friday, March 13th, and continued until the end of The Fair on Sunday, April 5th. The contents of these containers were collected periodically and were used to benefit the hungry of South Florida. Fairgoers who brought two cans of food per person to the designated tent area in the front gate area, received a coupon that could then be presented at any Main Gate Ticket Booth in order to receive a discount off admission.

UnitedHealthcare South Florida employees contributed to the Give a Meal, Get a Deal program by donating more than 700 canned goods. During a one month period this spring, 500+ employees who brought canned goods to designated collection stations received a \$4 discount on admission to the Youth Fair for every two cans donated.
