The Youth Fair opens March 17th

WHAT:

Media will have a first glimpse of NEW thriller, KMG Hurricane and KiddieLand Too's Elephant themed ride! Also, 170 food concessions featuring new items such as the **Funnel Bacon on a Stick, Fire and Ice Sundae, the Big Rib, Specialty Pretzel and many more.** In addition, 130 merchandise shops, over 50,000 student and adult exhibits and 50 games.

The KMG Hurricane, KiddieLand Too's Elephant themed ride and other rides are being tested the day before The Youth Fair starts its 65th Anniversary run. It will also be a chance for media to see this year's layout. A sneak peak of certain new foods will also be available to media that schedule this in advance.

Media will also have access to the market animals check-in. Inside the World of Agriculture Tent, exhibitors will put their animals on a scale and have them weighed in. This includes steers, swine and lambs.

DETAILS: The Youth Fair runs from March 17 – April 10, 2016, except March 28-29 and April

4-5 at Tamiami Park, which has been its home for 44 years, located at Coral Way

(SW 24th Street) & SW 107th Avenue.

Gates open at 3:00 p.m. March 17, 18, 30, 31, April 1, 6 & 7. Gates open at 12 p.m. all other operating days. Admission at the gate is \$14 with free admission all day, every operating day for guests 5 years and younger and guests 65 years and better. Admission is also free all day for active duty and retired military personnel (with valid military ID) on Opening Day, March 17 and each Wednesday.

Returning in 2016 is The Youth Fair 21-Day Admission Pass, which allows guests to pay \$25 for one admission each operating day and includes one free Souvenir Cup. Additional discount offers and coupons are available at www.FairExpo.com. Parking is free every day, all day. The Pay One Price Unlimited Ride Card is \$28 weekdays, \$35 on weekends at the fairgrounds. Tickets may be purchased at www.fairexpo.com
