Miami-Dade Youth Fair wins big at international competition Takes home 24 awards from International Association of Fairs and Exposition

MIAMI, Fla. – Dec. 23, 2015 – The Miami-Dade Youth Fair & Exposition representatives walked onto the stage 24 times to receive awards this month at the 125th International Association of Fairs and Exposition (IAFE) Convention in Las Vegas.

"We are proud to come home from the IAFE competition with more than twice the awards **we won last year, including a 'Best of Division' award.** It is humbling to know that our peers continue to rank us among the top fairs in the United States and Canada," said Robert Hohenstein, president and chief executive officer.

The Youth Fair staff, in going up against nearly 1,200 fairs from around the world, accepted **the 'Best of Division in Competitive Exhibits' award plus** eight first-place awards, six second-place awards and nine third-place awards. Industry leaders from across the United States and Canada judged the entries.

In addition to the awards ceremony, The Youth Fair attendees used the opportunity to showcase winning exhibits, attend educational seminars and evaluate new entertainment and vendors.
