Expect delays Sunday, Oct. 11, on Coral Way near 109th Avenue SW 17th Street will be closed between SW 107th and SW 117th avenues during Miami Broward Carnival 2015

MIAMI, Fla. – Oct. 5, 2015 – Traffic delays are expected Sunday, Oct. 11, during the Miami Broward Carnival 2015 celebration of Caribbean culture taking place at Tamiami Park and on the fairgrounds of the Miami-Dade County Youth Fair & Exposition, 10901 Coral Way (SW 24th Street), Miami FL 33165.

Guests attending the event are advised to arrive early for the noontime Masquerade Parade, which attracted 20,000 guests last year. The parade will continue for more than seven hours with 20 bands performing.

Parking entrances and gates into the fairgrounds will open at 9 a.m. Parking is free.

The parking lot entrance and exit will be allowed only on Coral Way (SW 24th Street) at SW 112th Avenue for westbound traffic and at SW 114th Avenue for eastbound traffic. Turnpike traffic is advised to take Exit 25 at SW 8th Street or Exit 23 at Bird Road.

During this time, SW 17th Street will be closed between SW107th Avenue and SW 117th Avenue.

Guests are encouraged to pre-purchase tickets online at www.miamibrowardcarnival.com to enjoy the best viewing experience of the Carnival inside the fairgrounds. Tailgating and the sale of food and beverage is strictly prohibited in all parking areas.
