New Fabulous Fair Foods at The Youth Fair

MIAMI, FL – March 2019 – The 2019 Miami-Dade County Youth Fair & Exposition is back with new foods, crazy creations and fabulous flavors, plus of course all your favorite traditional fair foods. With nearly 100 food concession stands, you can find something for every palate and for those on a diet, there are also plenty of low carb options that are Keto friendly.

New Foods:

- The unique **Dee's Ice Cream Waffle** is served with toppings such as chocolate, sliced fruits, berries and/or ice cream, topped with sprinkles, fresh whipped cream and your favorite syrup. Simple Dee's-licious! (*Location 8765L*)



- The **Dilly Dilly Corn Dog** by the Meatball Factory is a corn dog stuffed with a pickle. The pickle's center is cored out and the hot dog is placed inside the pickle. It is then dipped in a homemade corn dog batter and fried until golden brown. (*Location 218*)



- **Fluffy's Donut Sundae** allows you to choose from 14 different types of donuts, which are made into a sundae and topped with chocolate or strawberry sauce. Some of the donuts include Oreo, Butter Finger, S'mores, vanilla frosted Fruity Pebbles, Nutter Butter, Guava and Dulce de Leche. (*Location 354*)



- The **Brazilian Cheesecake Funnel Cake** by Best Around Foods is a traditional funnel cake with cream cheese glaze, chocolate syrup, dulce de leche and a variety of different nuts chopped up on top. (*Location 246*)



- **The Impossible Burger** by The Youth Fair's own Fair Expo Grille is a vegan option that is nut and dairy-free, made from plants, which contains no animal products. It is topped with choice of lettuce, tomatoes, onions, mayo and ketchup and served with sweet potato fries. (*Location 920*)



- The **Twisted Spicy Corn** by Meester Mikes of Coral Gables is corn with homemade spicy mayo, sriracha and special seasonings. (*Location 222*)



- **Oreo Crepes** by Miami Specialty Crepes are French crepes stuffed with chocolate cake and Oreos topped with whipped cream or ice cream. The top also has chocolate fudge with a white frosting cream and powdered sugar. (*Location 737*)



- **Bacon Wrapped Pork or Chicken Shish Kabobs Wrapped in Bacon** by Meatball Factory are fresh pork or chicken chunks on a skewer wrapped with thick delicious bacon, then grilled over our natural charcoal grills to give the perfect crisp bite. (*Location 387*)



- **Twist Churros with Guava & Cheese** from Churromania is an Irresistible combination of freshly made Churros glazed with a Latin twist of Guava and Cream Cheese. (*Location 433*)



- **Spicy Tilapia Filets** by Atlantic Concessions are fried spicy tilapia filets with homemade Cajun tartar sauce. (*Location 239*)
